**WEST WILTSHIRE DISTRICT AIR QUALITY
MANAGEMENT AREA (WESTBURY) ORDER 2001**

West Wiltshire District Council (“the Council”) is satisfied that as a result of its air quality review and assessment dated January 2001 the air quality objective for nitrogen dioxide (NO₂ annual average) is not likely to be achieved by 31 December 2005 (being the relevant period prescribed by the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000 N^o 928) in the area described below for reasons of the current and projected levels of nitrogen dioxide which exceed the objective levels set by the Air Quality Regulations for that period.

West Wiltshire District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 83 of the Environment Act 1995 hereby makes the following order:-

- 1 This Order may be cited as “West Wiltshire District Council Air Quality Management Area (Westbury) Order 2001”.
- 2 The Air Quality Management Area will be an air quality management area in relation to nitrogen dioxide only.
- 3 The area is described as “The following roads and buildings with facades on the roads”:

Westbury

1. Haynes Road from house number 23 up to the junction with Warminster Road; and
2. Warminster Road from its junction with Haynes Road to the junction with Leigh Road.

The area is shown for the purpose of identification only marked red on the map prepared and marked “Air Quality Management Area - Westbury”.

- 4 The Order will come into operation on _____ and shall remain in force until varied or revoked by subsequent Order.
